Job Announcement for Part-Time Life Science/Health Science/EJ OST Teacher

Job Announcement

The Baltimore Wisdom Project (BWP) of Wisdom Projects, Inc., a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization headquartered in Baltimore City, seeks a part-time (PT) teacher of life science, environmental justice, and/or health science for youth aged (approximately) 8-17 within our after school (out-of-school time) project. Secondary teaching proficiency in performing arts and cultural studies is welcome. Wisdom Projects, Inc., the nonprofit organization, will be the teacher's employer. The teacher's compensation will have taxes withheld (meaning, this position is *not* an independent contractor). The teacher's contract will be for ten months beginning on Monday September 20, 2021 and ending Sunday July 31, 2022 (with prorating for two weeks of work in September and June). This position is ideal for teacher-healers who already have a part-time educational or healing practice and who seek to enhance their career.

Remuneration and Benefits

1. **Salary:** The PT Teacher will receive a monthly stipend of \$1,000 (before taxes are withheld). This breaks down to **\$20 an hour**; 10 hours a week; 43 weeks or 10 months; \$866.67 a month in salary; plus a \$133.33 monthly bonus. The teacher must work 10 hours a week for Wisdom Projects, Inc. Exact afternoon hours to-be-announced, but applicants must be available in the afternoon.
2. **Benefits:** If the PT Teacher does not have other means for health insurance, Wisdom Projects, Inc. will place the employee on its company health insurance plan with Kaiser Permanente. This means that, during the contract, Wisdom Projects, Inc. will cover the employee's full monthly premium while the employee pays for all other individual healthcare costs.

Job Requirements

1. The teacher will report directly to the CEO of the Baltimore Wisdom Project, carrying out her and the company's educational and health agenda in full at all times.
2. The teacher should have a Bachelor's degree and teaching experience within STEM, life science, and/or health science. A background in evidence-based health and wellness (such as holistic health, nursing, nursing assistance, social work, or counseling) is also welcome.
3. In addition to teaching workshops, the PT Teacher must be able to serve as a behavioral health support specialist in the field for youth.
4. The teacher must be able to support the set-up and breakdown of learning spaces, taking care to help out appreciably at all times.
5. The teacher must be able to lift 25kg or approximately 50 lbs.
6. The teacher must be extremely punctual, reliable, honest, ethical, professional, pleasant, customer-friendly, and trustworthy.
7. The teacher must have a positive, non-toxic, non-discriminatory social media presence.
8. The teacher must be able to execute work in an accepting, affirming, friendly, supportive, and positive manner with culturally diverse people, including African American and LGBTQ people and abide by the company's nondiscrimination policy (<https://baltimorewisdomproject.org/non-discrimination-policy.html>).
9. The teacher must reside/work in Baltimore city or close by our Baltimore job sites in the DMV area so travel never impacts punctuality and reliability.
10. The teacher must be vaccinated against COVID-19 and its variants, including booster shots if available and applicable.
11. The teacher must abide by all human resources policies at all times.
12. This role requires the utmost of discretion, privacy, confidentiality, and adherence to HIPAA and FERPA regulations.
13. The teacher must pass a full background check and be free of arrests and convictions for at least the past seven years.
14. The teacher must be 100% smoking-free (all substances), drinking-free, and drugs-free.
15. The teacher must commit to ongoing lesson planning, training, and professional development at the direction of the CEO.
